

REPORT ON BEST PAPER AWARDS

To encourage contribution towards scientific knowledge, IDA presents the Best Paper Award for its two journals-Indian Dairyman and Indian Journal of Dairy Science (IJDS). The paper is judged by a panel of eminent dairy scientists. The Best Paper Award is presented to the awardee during the Annual Dairy Industry Conference. In Indian Dairyman, there are two categories, viz., Commercial Aspects of Dairying and Technical Aspect of Dairy Sector, under which the award is presented. In IJDS, there are three categories, viz., Dairy Production, Dairy Processing and Economics & Extension.

Under the First category award, a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/-is given to the author whereas Rs. 6000/-cash prize is given to the Second category award.

During the Plenary Session of the 50th Dairy Industry Conference (DIC) at Hyderabad, Telangana, the Best Paper Awards were presented for the year 2022.
